Teleskill e-learning 2.0 now available on Moodle. An interview with Emanuele Pucci

During the development of the MOODLE module for Teleskill e-learning 2.0, we had the opportunity to interview Emanuele Pucci, CEO of Teleskill.

Q: Birth of a new Moodle module – *Teleskill e-learning 2.0*. Why are you dedicating so much energy to this sector?

A: E-learning 2.0 is the new frontier of distance learning that integrates traditional e-learning methods with interactive synchronised activities in a unique training session. Based on this conviction, we decided to apply the concept of e-learning 2.0 to one of the most common distance learning platforms in the world: Moodle. The *Teleskill e-learning* 2.0 module specifically developed for Moodle allows us to use the synchronous training tool – *Teleskill Live* – within the platform itself.

Thanks to the A.P.I. developed for all *Teleskill Live* functionalities, Moodle allows for a virtual class completely integrated on LMS with the possibility to create a blended training path comprising on demand training and virtual classrooms and the option to automatically upload virtual class recordings (also in SCORM format). Last but not least, you can get complete training records of all participants with details and statistics on their attendance to virtual classrooms and on-demand courses as well as to the results of direct and on-demand questionnaires.

We believe that *Teleskill e-learning 2.0* represents a concrete solution for SMEs, schools and universities that will help boost change and competitivity by creating added value, increasing business culture, entrepreneurial spirit and supplying continuous learning that will help overcome this economical downturn.

Q: E-learning 2.0 is an ever more popular concept on the web and now, as we mentioned, is also available on Moodle. What does it actually add to Moodle's distance learning?

A: It adds much. As I said, it allows to organise a blended training program, mixed, that is, with on demand e-learning modules and live virtual class activities. Both are easy to arrange, with easily definable preparatory levels. Moreover, and this is a novelty, it allows to easily collect and analyse complete training records, participation to live virtual classes or on-demand e-learning sessions and answers to questionnaires of all attendees.

Q: Moodle has already adopted it, and this is good proof. Why do you believe Teleskill e-learning 2.0 to be an attractive product now?

A: It is attractive because of the times we are going through. Speed and effective communication between people within organisations, and their relationships with the external context, are key factors for change. For many years now *Teleskill* has been focusing on on-line multimedia communication to create or rapidly spread skills and has implemented its own technological tools and methods that integrate new communication methods on the web. After gaining considerable experience in traditional e-learning applications and methods, today we enrich them with live communication tools: video conferencing, web meeting, evolved SCORM recording, sharing of multimedia information, general and targeted web communication. Basically *Teleskill e-learning 2.0* is composed of tools that synergically work together and, given that they are all designed and implemented in *Teleskill*, they are adaptable to all customers needs.

Q: I read some of your brochures and was struck by the term "social e-learning". What does it mean?

A: Just what we all mean by "social". Teleskill e-learning 2.0 interprets the need for many users to adapt their training tools to new social contexts. It allows them to create a customised training and communication programme allowing them to adapt to new scenarios and changes. *Teleskill e-learning 2.0* allows to reduce (or even eliminate) all course related production costs and supports users interactivity.

Classical communities of practice are also enriched by a web conferencing tool that allows live online discussion on topics of interest of a specific group of users.

Collaborative training is, in fact, at the base of social e-learning. With the adoption of Teleskill Live it will be possible, for instance, to add audio/video contents to normal text posts, thus adding an extra to communication and dialogue and, thus, more attention will be paid by users to the skills generated by the community.
